Y.J.O. to Host "Facing the Challenges Forum" Feb 9/07

In April 2006, MCYS - Youth Justice Services commissioned a review of the Open Detention/Open Custody sector in Ontario – now called the *Open Custody/Detention Transformation Project*. The review has produced a FINAL REPORT and a set of RECOMMENDATIONS that have gone to the senior management level of YJS. However, *neither the REPORT nor the RECOMMENDATIONS have yet been made public.*

Obviously, the operationalization of the RECOMMENDATIONS from the REPORT will have a significant impact on the *nature* of the Open System, on the *service providers* that comprise the Open System and on the youths, families, & communities that will benefit from it.

To assist in the implementation of these recommendations, Youth Justice Ontario is organizing a consultation process across the province. Please look for your consultation package to arrive in the next few weeks and then plan to attend Feb. 9th 2007 at the Airport Travel Lodge Hotel, 925 Dixon Rd. Etobicoke On. M9W 1J8.

Fund Raising Plan Announcement

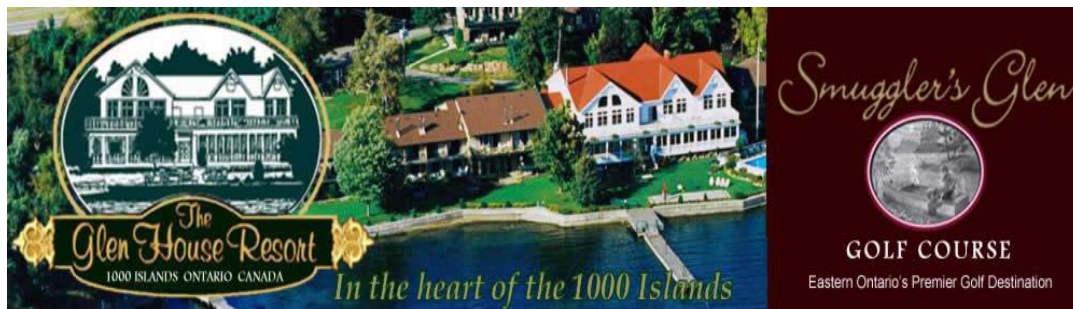
The Board has decided that the value of this initiative is important enough to address the concerns and pursue the ability to follow through with this activity. To this end the Board has decided on a two-prong approach.

1. Create a secondary arm of the Youth Justice Ontario that would be a registered charitable organization.
2. Identify a single agency that is already registered as a charitable organization, to apply for a municipal permit to run the current fund raising plan. (Any fund raising activity generating less than \$50,000.00 falls under the municipality level as oppose to the provincial jurisdiction.) Please understand that this is an interim strategy to accommodate the current situation.

Hopefully within a few months Y.J.O. will be able to offer this same fundraising plan with a permit/license in place to alleviate any outstanding concerns.
